- B. West Allis Youth Basketball – Background
 - a. Bulldogs
 - b. Huskies
 - c. We ARE in constant contact with the high schools and consult with the varsity coaches often
- C. Purpose of each program
 - a. Develop players so they are ready for high school basketball
 - b. Compete against all other local communities
 - c. Learn the fundamentals of the game
 - d. More practices – More games
 - e. Enjoy the game of basketball
- D. Leagues
 - a. Boys play in the WIBL – most games out at Center Court in Waukesha
 - i. Each grade has a set night to play. Last years Mondays (7th), Wednesday (5th) & Thursdays (6th) – 8th grade is all over
 - ii. Plus weekend league games
 - b. Girls play in Lake Country Girls Basketball league
 - i. League play for girls is typically on weekend
- E. Tournaments
 - a. Boys will play in 4 – 8 tournaments throughout the season
 - b. Girls typically play in a couple tournaments
- F. Practices
 - a. Two times per week, 1 ½ or 2 hours per
 - b. At night, may be after the high schools are done (7:30 to 9:00 or 9:30)
- G. Tryouts
 - a. Two nights of tryouts per team, every effort should be made to be at each tryout.
 - b. Evaluate skills, attitude, hustle
 - c. Will keep 8-12 players per team
 - d. You can choose to try out for the Bulldogs or the Huskies or both.
 - i. If you tryout for both, please let the coaches know. We will also work with you so that you can attend both tryouts
 - e. Registration Form – please complete prior to tryouts so we can contact you
 - f. Calls will come shortly after tryouts.
- H. Cost
 - a. Boys - roughly \$2500 - \$3000 per team with league costs, court rental, tournaments and insurance
 - b. Girls – roughly \$1500 per team
 - c. Cost will range from \$200 to \$300 per player for the boys and between \$125 to \$200 for the girls – League costs are not yet set
 - d. Uniforms are handled differently for each group
 - i. Bulldogs – Property of the club
 - ii. Huskies – yours to keep
- I. Fundraising
 - a. Each group will handle their own fundraising effort
- J. Volunteers – Please offer your services!
 - a. Bulldogs – looking for coaches at various levels
 - b. Huskies – Currently looking for a 7th grade girls coach
- K. Other sports
 - a. Football – We will work around football during Sept & Oct
 - b. Intermediate School basketball – During that season the kids will have a lot of basketball, there will be nights when they have two practices. It is two different programs. Play both if you desire
 - c. Rec Leagues – We expect if a child plays in a rec league as well as this basketball that the rec league is secondary to this.
